



This form will help you determine whether you meet the exemption criteria. Make sure you read the exemption criteria carefully. You do not need to apply for an exemption but it is your responsibility to satisfy police that you can meet the relevant exemption criteria each time you get behind the wheel.

This form is designed to help you comply with the exemptions and you are encouraged to complete the information on the next page. You may also wish to ask your employer to provide their details or perhaps provide a signed letter or some other form of evidence of your need to drive a UHPV. Keep this information with you when driving to provide to police if asked.

You should be aware that this form is not a legal document and does not mean that you are automatically exempt from holding a U class licence. If police aren't satisfied with the level of information provided they may conduct further investigations.



Employment Exemption

Applies to C class licence holders who are required to drive an ultra high powered vehicle in the course of their employment.

The employment exemption does not apply to persons who hold a learner's permit, or a provisional licence or a licence with the class R or R Date only

Exemption Criteria:

- Employed (including self employed or contracted) at a motor vehicle related workplace AND
• Required to drive an ultra high powered vehicle on a road in the course of their employment

Motor vehicle related workplace are workplaces where the primary business relates to the repair, sale, trade, inspection or transport of motor vehicles, or the renting or leasing out of motor vehicles.

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Examples where an employment exemption may be applicable:

- Contracted heavy vehicle driver unloading vehicles including UHPVs off of a car carrier truck to drive them into the dealership property
• Employed person managing a hire car fleet including some UHPVs, and needs to manage the fleet movements and vehicle placement within yard (eg move vehicle to wash bay, moving vehicles around the property)
• Self employed mechanic driving a UHPV around the block (to diagnose a fault or to confirm that a vehicle fault has been rectified)



## Test Drive Exemption

Applies to a C class licence holder who is purchasing a UHPV from a motor vehicle dealer who sells UHPVs;

*The test drive exemption does not apply to persons who hold a learner's permit, or a provisional licence or a licence with the class R or R Date only*

Enables a prospective purchaser of a UHPV to drive a UHPV for the purpose of a test drive to determine if they wish to purchase, as long as:

- The person must be accompanied by an employee of the motor vehicle dealer who holds a U class licence and who is seated in the front passenger seat for the entire duration of the test drive;
- The dealership employee to take all reasonable steps to supervise and instruct the prospective purchaser in the safe and efficient driving of the vehicle;
- The person must not drive the vehicle at a speed higher than the posted speed limit or at a maximum speed of 100km/h.

### Note:

**This exemption does not replace the insurance or identification requirements of a UHPV motor vehicle dealer and does not apply to private sales.**
